DEFINITIONS

Recognised Standard Parts (CAO 95.10 Section 2).

A list of commercially available parts which do not require separate substantiation were such substantiation required. The designer of the part is responsible for specifying the purpose intended for the part.

Maintenance Authentication

Maintenance Authentication is the action of signing the aircraft log book by a suitably qualified person underneath the listing of all maintenance carried out at that time and formally indicating that the maintenance conducted at that time is to the standard specified in the AUF Technical Manual. All maintenance must be authenticated by an appropriate person as specified in this AUF Technical Manual. Persons authenticating maintenance are to sign the aircraft log book, print their name and initials, their AUF membership number and the date they signed the document.
